#### A BILL INTITULED

An Act to change the Purposes for which a certain Portion of the Title. Public Reserve known as "Russell Park," situated in the Town District of Waipukurau, was vested in the Waipukurau Town Board.

WHEREAS by Proclamation made on the twenty-fifth day of Sep- Preamble. tember, nineteen hundred and seven, and published in the New Zealand Gazette of the third day of October, nineteen hundred and seven, the piece of land described in the Schedule hereto was (with 10 other land) taken for the purposes of a public recreation-ground and vested in the Waipukurau Town Board: And whereas the said piece of land, being cut off from the remainder of the land described in the said Proclamation by a public road, is not required for the purposes aforesaid: And whereas the Waipukurau Town Board is 15 desirous of using the said piece of land for the purposes of a public

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:---

- 20 1. This Act may be cited as the Waipukurau Reserve Act, Short Title. 1909.
- 2. The piece of land described in the Schedule hereto shall no Site for a public longer be appropriated as an endowment for the purposes herein-pound. before recited, but shall be and remain vested in the Waipukurau 25 Town Board for the purposes of a public pound.
