A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to authorize the Governor to grant to the Superintendent of Wellington certain Land, being part of the bed of the River Wanganui. Title.

WHEREAS it is expedient that the land described in the Schedule hereto, being part of the bed of the River Wanganui, should be granted to the Superintendent of Wellington : Preamble.

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

1. The Short Title of this Act shall be "The Wanganui River Foreshore Grant Act, 1873." Short Title.

2. The Governor, with the advice of his Executive Council, may, under the provisions of the second section of "The Public Reserves Act, 1854," grant to the Superintendent of Wellington and his successors the land described in the Schedule hereto, but such grant shall not prejudice the rights of any persons claiming and entitled to water frontage. Governor empowered to grant, under "The Public Reserves Act, 1854," the land described in the Schedule.

SCHEDULE.

Schedule.

ALL that piece of land, containing twenty-nine acres more or less, being a portion of the right side of the River Wanganui, lying between the production of the north-eastern boundary of country section No. 11, and the production of the north-eastern boundary of suburban section No. 14, and bounded towards North-east by a line of 5 feet in depth at low water spring tides; towards the South-east by a line of 3 feet in depth at low water spring tides; and towards the North-west and South-west by the line of high water spring tides.
