## A BILL INTITULED

An Aot to amend the Wyndham Recreation Reserve Act, Titie. 1877.

BE I'T ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand
5 in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:-

1. This Act may be cited as the Wyndham Recreation Reserve short Title. Amendment Act, 1915, and shall form part of and be read together with the Wyndham Recreation Reserve Act, 1877 (hereinafter 10 referred to as the principal Act).
2. Section two of the principal Act is hereby repealed.
3. The land described in the Schedule to the principal Act is section 2 of hereby vested in the Wyndham Town Board, and the trustees in whom the said land is vested immediately prior to the passing of this
15 Act shall on the passing of this Act vacate their office.
4. Section four of the principal Act is hereby amended by Section 4 of omitting the words "Wyndham Recreation Reserve Trust," and principal act substituting the words " Wyndham Town Board."
5. Section five of the principal Act is hereby amended-
(a.) By omitting the words "Wyndham Recreation Reserve Trust,", and substituting the words "Wyndham J'own Board" ; and
(b.) By omitting the words "one year," and substituting the words " three years."
