A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to provide for the Establishment of a School of Design, Technics, and other Educational Purposes in the City of Wellington, and for the vesting of certain Lands situate in the said City in the Education Board of the District of Wellington, and the Mayor, Councillors, and Citizens of the City of Wellington respectively.

WHEREAS it is expedient to provide for the erection in the City of Wellington of a School of Design, Technics, and other Educational Purposes: And whereas the land described in the *First* Schedule hereto has been set apart for the purpose of a School of Art and site for an office for the Education Board of the District of Wellington: And whereas it having been found that the land described in the *Second* Schedule hereto, and belonging to the Mayor, Councillors, and citizens of the City of Wellington (hereinafter called "the Corporation"), is well adapted for the purpose of the proposed School of Design, Technics, and other Educational Purposes; and the Council of the City of Wellington and the Education Board of the District of Wellington assenting to this Act, it is desirable that the said several lands should respectively be vested in manner hereinafter appearing:

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Wellington School of Design and Exchange Act, 1890."

2. The land described in the *First* Schedule hereto is hereby absolutely vested in the Corporation to be held by it upon the same trusts with the same powers and in the same manner as the land described in the *Second* Schedule was held by it immediately before the coming into force of this Act.

3. The land described in the *Second* Schedule hereto is hereby absolutely vested in the Education Board of the District of Wellington as a site for a School of Design, Technics, and other Educational Purposes.

**SCHEDULES.****FIRST SCHEDULE.**

**DESCRIPTION OF LAND TO BE VESTED IN THE WELLINGTON CORPORATION.**  
ALL that piece of land containing 30·6 perches, more or less, being Sections Nos. 3 and 5, Block III., on the plan of the Thorndon reclaimed land, in the City of Wellington.

**SECOND SCHEDULE.**

**DESCRIPTION OF LAND TO BE VESTED IN THE WELLINGTON EDUCATION BOARD.**  
ALL that parcel of land situate in the City of Wellington, and forming part of the lands reclaimed from the sea by the Wellington City Corporation under the provisions of "The Te Aro Reclamation Act, 1879," containing 1 rood 7·45 perches. Bounded by Mercer Street, 151·52 links, on the north-east; by a line, 224·33 links, at right angles to Mercer Street on the south-east; by Victoria Street, 162·03 links, on the south-west; and by a line, 166·92 links, at right angles to Mercer Street on the north-west; and being Lot 2 on a plan prepared by Mr. A. P. Mason, authorised surveyor, and certified by him under date of the 26th May, 1890.
