## A BILL INTITULED

An Act to vest a certain Reserve at Wyndham, in Title. Trustees for the Mataura Pastoral and Agricultural Society.

THEREAS the land described in the Schedule to this Act was, by Preamble. an Executive minute of the Provincial Government of Otago, on the nineteenth day of July, one thousand eight hundred and seventysix, set aside as a show-ground for the Mataura Pastoral and Agricul-5 tural Society: And whereas it is expedient to vest the management of the same in Trustees, in trust for the purposes for which the Society was formed:

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, 10 as follows:-

1. The Short Title of this Act shall be "The Wyndham Show- Short Title: Ground Reserve Act, 1877."

2. The land described in the Schedule to this Act shall be and Lands vested for the same is hereby vested in the Trustees hereinafter named in trust for agricultural and pastoral sassociation 15 the Mataura Pastoral and Agricultural Society, and for the purposes purposes. for which the said Society was formed.

3. The Trustees to the said land shall be James Milne, Oware; Trustees named and Donald Stalker, Oware; Edward Anderson, Glenham; James Alexander incorporated. Robertson Menzies, Dunalister; and the said Trustees, by the name of 20 "The Wyndham Show-Ground Reserve Trust," shall be a body corporate and may do and suffer all things that bodies corporate may do and suffer.

4. The Wyndham Reserve Trust shall manage the said lands in Trust to manage all respects as to the said Trust may deem expedient, but so that the lands. 20 lands shall be used for the purposes for which they have by this Act been set apart; and any rents or revenue the said Wyndham Reserve Trust shall receive shall be expended on the said lands: Provided Proviso. always that the Trustees may for seven days in a year close the said reserve to the public, and charge for admission to such reserve on 25 such days.

Members of Trust may become disqualified, and Governor may appoint other members. 5. If any of the members of the said Wyndham Show-Ground Reserve Trust shall die, or shall become bankrupt, or take the advantage of any law for the relief of insolvent debtors, or be convicted of any felony, or be absent from the Provincial District of Otago for nine months, then in any of the said cases such member shall cease to be a member of the said Trust; and the Governor may in any such case, or in case any member resigns his membership, appoint another or others in his place.
