A BILL INTITULED

An Act to facilitate the acquisition of a Site for a Title.

Telegraph Office in the City of Wellington.

WHEREAS the parcel of land particularly described in the Preamble. Schedule hereto being part of a parcel of land in the Harbour of Port Nicholson granted to the Superintendent of the Province of Wellington under the provisions of "The Public Reserves Act 1854" upon 5 certain trusts for the public service of the said Province and reclaimed from the sea at the cost of the Provincial Government of the said Province is required by the Electric Telegraph Commissioner who is hereinafter referred to as "the Commissioner" as a site for the offices of his department at Wellington And it is expedient that power 10 should be given to the Commissioner to purchase the said parcel of land hereinafter referred to as "the prescribed land" and to appropriate the same for the purposes aforesaid

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as

15 follows—

1. The Short Title of this Act shall be "The Wellington short Title.

Telegraph Office Site Act 1868."

2. The Commissioner may out of any moneys which may have Power to Commisbeen or may be placed at his disposal for such purposes by the sioner to purchase from the Superintendent of the Province of Wellington the parcel of land described in the Schedule hereto at and for such sum of money as shall represent the cost of reclaiming the said parcel of land from the sea and such cost shall be calculated as bearing the same proportion to the cost of reclaiming the whole 25 of the area of land comprised in the contract under which the said prescribed land was with other land reclaimed from the sea as the area of the said prescribed land bears to the total area comprised in such contract as aforesaid.

Lands Clauses Consolidation Act incorporated.

3. "The Lands Clauses Consolidation Act 1863" shall be incorporated with this Act with the exceptions and subject to the provisions

hereinafter contained that is to sav-

(1.) In the construction of this Act and the said incorporated Act this Act shall be deemed to be "the special Act" and 5 this Act and the said incorporated Act shall be read as if the expression "promoters of the undertaking" were in the singular number and the Commissioner shall be deemed to be the promoter of the undertaking the expressions "parties interested in the lands" "parties 10 enabled to sell convey or release" and "parties entitled to compensation" shall be read as if such expressions were in the singular number and as meaning and referring to the Superintendent of the Province of Wellington only.

(2.) The said incorporated Act shall be read as if instead of 15 the terms "compensation" "purchase money" and "value" or terms of similar import wherever the same respectively occur in the said Act words importing the proportionate cost of reclaiming the prescribed land

calculated as hereinbefore directed were used.

(3.) There shall not be incorporated with this Act the sections of "The Lands Clauses Consolidation Act 1863" hereinafter enumerated that is to say sections forty-four fortyfive forty-six forty-seven forty-eight, forty-nine fifty fifty-one fifty-two fifty-three and ninety-seven.

(4.) The said incorporated Act shall be read as if instead of the expressions therein relating to payment of moneys to the Colonial Treasurer or into the Colonial Treasury words had been used to express payment of the same moneys to the credit of the Public Account.

(5.) The prescribed land when the purchase money shall have been ascertained and paid in the manner provided by this Act and the said incorporated Act shall in the manner provided by the said Acts be conveyed to or made to vest in Her Majesty her heirs and successors for the 35 public uses of the Colony.

SCHEDULE.

All that parcel of land in the Harbour of Port Nicholson in the Province of Wellington reclaimed from the sea commencing at a point on the eastern side of Custom House Quay in a line with the northern side of Panama Street and running in an easterly direction at right angles to the line of Custom House Quay for seventy-eight feet thence in a southerly direction parallel to the line of Custom House Quay one hundred and thirty-eight feet thence in a westerly direction at right angles to the line of Custom House Quay for seventy-eight feet and thence along the eastern side of Custom House Quay one hundred and thirty-eight feet to the point of commencement.
