A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend "The Workmen's Wages Act, 1884."

Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand, in
5 Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Workmen's Wages Act
1884 Amendment Act, 1888." Short Title.

2. The employer of any person to whom wages are payable shall
10 pay to such person his or her wages within three days after the
termination of the engagement, or within three days after such
person's discharge, whichever first happens; and every employer who
neglects or refuses to make payment in manner aforesaid shall pay to
such person wages at the same rate of wages as those payable to
15 such person during the time such person was working for such em-
ployer till such wages are paid. Provided that not more than one
month's wages shall be recoverable under this section. Payment of wages.
