# LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL.

Wednesday, the 3rd Day of November, 1937.

### AIR FORCE BILL.

The Hon. Mr. FAGAN, in Committee, to move the following amendment:—

Clause 10: To omit subclause (1) of this clause, and substitute the following subclauses:—

(1) No person under the age of twenty-one years shall enlist or be accepted for service in the Air Force if either of his parents or his guardian objects thereto.

(1A) Every application by a minor for enlistment in the Air Force shall be accompanied by the consent in writing of one or both of his parents or of his guardian, or, in the alternative, shall state the reasons why such consent has not been obtained or furnished.

(1B) Except as provided in subsection *one* hereof, a minor who has not obtained the prior consent of one or both of his parents or of his guardian to his enlistment in the Air Force may be accepted for service therein with the approval of the Board, but not otherwise.
