**AUCKLAND HARBOUR BRIDGE EMPOWERING BILL.**

Hon. Mr. CARRINGTON, in Committee, to move the following new clause:—

18A. Such conditions of contract shall also provide that not less than seventy-five per centum of the total number of workmen employed in the work of the construction of the bridge shall have been domiciled in New Zealand for at least six months prior to the date on which the company is authorized by the provisions of this Act to commence the erection of the bridge.
