ACTS INTERPRETATION BILL.

Hon. Sir Francis Bell, in Committee, to move the following amendment:—

Clause 4 (page 5): To omit from the definition of the terms "writing" or "written" the words "and where anything is required to be written it may be partly in writing and partly in print," in lines 26 and 27.

Alternative Proposed Amendment.

To omit from the definition of the terms "writing" or "written" the words "it may be partly in writing and partly in print," and substitute the words "any one or more of the forms of writing herein specified may be used."
