ANIMALS PROTECTION BILL.

Hon. Dr. FINDLAY, in Committee, to move the following amendments:—

Clause 43: Add new subclause:—

(3.) In any district under the control of the Department of Tourist and Health Resorts "authorised person" includes any officer of the said Department acting under the written authority of the General Manager of such Department.

Clause 47: After paragraph (d) add the following proviso:—

Provided, however, that in any district under the control of the Department of Tourist and Health Resorts, all such fees and fines shall be paid and credited to the said Department in the same manner as if it were a registered acclimatisation society.

Clause 50 (e): After the words "any district" add the words "prohibiting or regulating the coursing, pursuing, or killing of hares in any confined space or enclosure."

Clause 50, subparagraph (i): Add subparagraph (ii):—

(ii.) Prohibiting or regulating the shooting or killing of pigeons released from any trap, box, or similar contrivance, or in any similar method.

Clause 54: At end of the clause add proviso:—

Provided that in any district administered by the Department of Tourist and Health Resorts the property in all animals and birds in the possession of or under the control of the said Department in such district shall be deemed to be vested in such Department.
