BANK OF NEW ZEALAND AND BANKING ACT AMENDMENT BILL.

Hon. Mr. W. C. Walker to move to recommit subclause (4) of clause 7, for

the purpose of substituting "six" in lieu of "five."

Also, to recommit subclause (3) of clause 14, for the purpose of inserting next after "shares or" the words "and also the words or partly of one class and partly of the other class." The paragraph in which this amendment occurs is to be numbered as a new subclause (3A).

Also, to recommit clause 16, for the purpose of omitting "abolition of the

office of President," and substituting "passing of this Act."

At the end of 16A add:—

"(1.) The Chief Auditor may by memorandum recorded in the Board's minute-book at such meeting or thereafter suspend the operation of any Act or proceeding of the Board until the Board has had an opportunity of further considering the same at a subsequent meeting.

"(2.) The result of such further consideration shall be recorded

in the Board's minute-book."

Also, to recommit clause 16B, for the purpose of omitting "coming into operation," and substituting "passing."
