BANK OF NEW ZEALAND AND BANKING ACT AMENDMENT BILL.

Hon. Mr. W. C. WALKER, in Committee, to move to insert the following new clauses to follow clause 16:—

16A. The Chief Auditor shall have the right to attend the meetings of the Board, but shall not take any part in the proceedings.

16B. From and after the coming into operation of this Act the power of veto theretofore possessed by the President shall be revoked, and in lieu thereof the Chief Auditor shall have the power to veto any act or proceeding of the Board as to which the Board is not unanimous.

16c. Every act or proceeding so vetoed shall be void, and the Chief Auditor shall forthwith report the matter to the Colonial Treasurer.
