A. The Governor may from time to time reserve any Crown lands, whether the same shall now be or shall at any time hereafter be comprised in a coal-mining lease, as he shall consider necessary or to be required for the use of any railway, or for railway-stations, or for any railways, tramways, bridges, inclines, and staiths, or other means of transit between any railway or tramway and any of the mines on the said lands which may be constructed by the Minister for Public Works, or by the lessee of any coal-mining lease, and thereafter the same shall be reserved and held for the said purposes and no other.

Any reserve made under authority of this section may be made as a temporary reserve, to take effect during the currency of any coal-mining lease, or for such other period and upon such conditions as to the Governor may seem necessary.
