CO-OPERATIVE DAIRY COMPANIES.

Hon. Dr. FINDLAY, in Committee, to move the following amendments:—

Clause 8: To omit subclause (2), and to substitute the following subclause:—

“(2A.) No demand for the surrender of any share shall be made under the authority of this section except in pursuance of a resolution of the shareholders of the company.”

To add the following new clause:—

Certain sections  
of Companies  
Act not to apply  
to co-operative  
dairy companies.

8A. Sections thirty-five, seventy, seventy-one, seventy-two, and seventy-three of the Companies Act, 1903, shall not apply to a co-operative dairy company which is registered under this Act, or whose articles of association provide for its registration under this Act.
