### DEFENCE AMENDMENT BILL.

Amendments proposed by His Excellency the Governor:—

Clause 74: To omit subclause (6), and substitute the following subclause:—

(6A.) The Governor may sell any drill-shed, rifle-range, or land vested in the Crown under this section, but the proceeds of any such sale shall be expended in manner following, and not otherwise:—

- (a.) In the purchase of land or the erection of buildings for the purposes of the Territorial Force in the locality in which the property so sold was situated; or
- (b.) In refunding to the Public Account any sums expended out of that account after the commencement of this Act in respect of any such purchase of land or erection of buildings in the said locality; or
- (c.) In refunding to the Public Account any sums advanced out of that account before the commencement of this Act to the trustees of the property so sold; or
- (d.) In discharging any liabilities transferred to the Crown under this section and charged upon or incurred in respect of the property so sold or any other property vested in the same trustees.

To add the following subclause:—

(8.) The provisions of this section shall apply, notwithstanding the provisions of any other Act whereby any such property as aforesaid is vested in trustees or whereby the powers or duties of the trustees of any such property are prescribed, and every such Act is hereby repealed so far as it so vests any such property in trustees or confers or imposes upon trustees any powers or duties in respect of such property or is inconsistent with the foregoing provisions of this section.
