The Honourable Mr. Sewell to move, on the third reading of the Dunedin and Port Chalmers Railway Bill, the following new clause:—

The promoters of the undertaking shall make and at all times thereafter maintain such and so many gates and passages for the accommodation of owners and occupiers of land adjoining the said lands below high watermark as shall be prescribed by Order in Council within six months after the passing of this Act and in the opinion of the Governor be reasonably required for the purpose of giving access across such Railway to and from the harbour from and to the lands adjoining the said lauds below high watermark.
