The rate to be levied under this Act shall be a special rate within the meaning of sections one hundred and twelve, one hundred and thirteen, and one hundred and fourteen of "The Counties Act, 1876;" but the proceeds of such rate shall not be paid into nor form part of the County Fund of the County of Selwyn, and shall be paid into a separate account, to be called "The Malvern Water Supply Account."

The County Fund of the County of Selwyn shall not nor shall any property of the county be liable for the repayment of the loan hereby authorized to be raised or any part thereof.
