EDUCATION RESERVES AMENDMENT BILL.

Hon. Dr. FINDLAY, in Committee, to move the following new clause :—

Provision for
employees of
School
Commissioners.

A. (1.) In any case where a person, who on the passing of this Act is in the service of any School Commissioners, is appointed to the public service, he shall for the purposes of computing his superannuation allowance under the Public Service Classification and Superannuation Amendment Act, 1908, be entitled to count his service under the School Commissioners as public service, and such service shall be deemed to have been continuous, notwithstanding any interval that may elapse between such abolition and such appointment to the public service.

(2.) Any such person may, at any time within three months after his appointment as aforesaid, elect to pay into the fund the amount of contributions that would have been payable by him if he had been so appointed on the first day of April, nineteen hundred and eight, together with interest thereon at the rate of five per centum per annum from that date to the date of making such payment; and on such payment he shall be deemed to have been, as from the said first day of April, nineteen hundred and eight, an original contributor to the fund.
