EDUCATION RESERVES AMENDMENT BILL.

Mr. Bell, in Committee, to move the following amendments:

Clause 3: To add the following as a new subclause:-

(5A.) The owner of the lease or license shall be entitled within one month after the first notification by the Land Board defining the subdivisions, and naming the rents or upset rental for each subdivision and the term of years for which the new leases are to be offered, to require, by notice in writing to the Land Board, that a lease of one of such subdivisions, to be selected and named by him in such notice, shall be granted to him at the rent or upset rent so named by the Land Board.

Clause 3, subclause (6): To amend this subclause by adding thereto the following:—

Provided that if the owner of the lease or license exercises the power conferred upon him by subsection five(A) hereof, compensation shall not be paid in respect of any improvements upon or of any matter relating to the subdivision in respect of which the owner shall so exercise such power.
