GAMING AMENDMENT BILL (No. 2).

Hon. Sir Francis Bell, in Committee, to move the following new clause:—

Validation of licenses issued

4. The licenses to use the totalizator at race meetings issued by the Minister of Internal Affairs to the New Zealand Metropolitan special occasions. Trotting Club in respect of a race meeting held on the sixth day of September, nineteen hundred and nineteen, in honour of the visit to New Zealand of Admiral Viscount Jellicoe, and to the Auckland Racing Club and the Canterbury Jockey Club in respect of race meetings held on the twenty-sixth day of April and the fifteenth day of May, nineteen hundred and twenty, respectively, in honour of the visit to New Zealand of His Royal Highness the Prince of Wales, are hereby declared to have been validly issued, and the issue of those licenses shall not be deemed to reduce the number of licenses that may be issued or the number of days on which the totalizator may be used in the racing-year commenced on the first day of August, nineteen hundred and twenty.
