LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL.

Monday, the 26th day of July, 1886.

STANDING ORDERS ON PRIVATE BILLS REFERRED TO IN ORDER OF THE DAY No. 1.

69. The Committee on each Bill shall, from time to time, appoint the day upon which they will enter upon the consideration of such Bill, and on which they will require the parties severally promoting or opposing the same to enter appearances; and two clear days' notice at the least of such appointment shall be given by the Examiner in his office.

76. Every Private Bill, as amended in Committee, shall be printed at the expense of the parties applying for the same, and delivered to the Clerk for the use of the members two clear days at least before the consideration of the Bill.

GOVERNMENT LOANS TO LOCAL BODIES BILL.

The Honourable Sir F. WHITAKER, K.C.M.G., in Committee, to move the following amendment:—

Clause 36. To omit the first paragraph and these words in line 1 of the second paragraph, "If no such resolution is passed," with a view of inserting the following words in lieu thereof:—

The Treasurer may in each year lend to local authorities under this Act such sum as shall be appropriated by Parliament for that purpose.

If no such sum be appropriated.

COUNTIES BILL.

The Honourable Mr. MILLER, on the recommittal of the Counties Bill, to move that the following be added to clause 198:—

Provided always that the total amount of all rates—general, separate, and special—levied in one year in any county or part of a county shall not exceed                      farthings in the pound.

The Honourable Mr. BARNICOAT, on the recommittal of the Counties Bill, to move that the following be inserted in clause 308, between subsections (12) and (13):—

For regulating the times at which traction-engines may be allowed to pass along the roads within the county.
