LEGISLATURE AMENDMENT BILL.

Hon. Mr. REED, in Committee, to move the following amendment:—

Clause 2: To add the following subclause:—

(1A) Every person making application for a postal vote-certificate and postal ballot-paper shall make a declaration in the prescribed form and sign the same with his own hand in the presence of a witness who shall be a Registrar or Deputy Registrar, the Chief Electoral Officer or other officer of the Electoral Department authorized by the Chief Electoral Officer, member of the Police Force, Justice of the Peace, Postmaster, head teacher of a State school, registered medical practitioner, registered hospital nurse, or solicitor of the Supreme Court, and in the case of an applicant under paragraph (e) a lighthouse-keeper or a member of a lighthouse-keeper's staff.
