LAND LAWS AMENDMENT BILL.

Hon. Sir FRANCIS BELL, in Committee, to move the following amendments:—

Clause 6: To omit the words “either the Dominion Land Purchase Board or the Local Land Purchase Boards,” and substitute the words “the Dominion Land Purchase Board or of any Local Land Purchase Board.”

Clause 11: To insert after subclause (15) the following subclause:—

(15A.) On the surrender or forfeiture of any license under this section, there shall be payable to the licensee the value, if any, of the improvements effected by him in excess of the amount owing by him to the Crown in respect of the said land and outstanding at the date of forfeiture or surrender. The amount so payable shall be paid by the person to whom the land is next disposed of by the Crown, either under the authority of this section or otherwise under the provisions of the Land Act, 1908, and until so paid shall be a charge on the land.

Clause 20, subclause (3): To omit the proviso, and substitute the following proviso:—

“Provided that if such valuation has been made at any time earlier than two years before the date of the acquisition of the land by way of aggregation a fresh valuation shall be made by the Valuer-General, as at that date, and that valuation shall be deemed to be the Government valuation for the purposes of this section.”

Clause 27, subclause (1): To omit the words “five thousand,” in line 32, and substitute the words “six thousand.”
