LAND LAWS AMENDMENT BILL.

Hon. Sir Francis Bell, in Committee, to move the following amendments:—

Clause 11, subclause (1): To insert, after the word "section" in line 20, the words "and of section thirteen a hereof."

Clause 12, subclause (1): To insert at the beginning of the subclause the words "Save as provided by section thirteen a hereof."

To add the following new clause after clause thirteen:—

13a. (1.) Where the land comprised in a pastoral run or any part of such land is a State forest or a provisional State forest the right to acquire the freehold of such land conferred by section eleven hereof shall be subject to the approval and consent of the Commissioner of State Forests, and shall not be exercisable without such approval and consent.

(2.) No Proclamation shall be made or issued under the powers conferred by section twelve hereof in respect of any national-endowment lands forming part of a State forest or provisional State forest, except upon the advice of the Commissioner of State Forests

given prior to the approval by the Executive Council.
