MINING BILL.

Hon. Mr. W. C. Walker, in Committee, to move to amend clause 195 by making it subclause (1), and also by adding the following new subclause:—

(2.) Section twenty-four of "The Mining Companies Act, 1894," is hereby repealed in so far, but so far only, as it prohibits a manager or secretary of any mining company from carrying on business or acting as a sharebroker for the sale or disposal in any way of shares in mining companies liable to the provisions of that Act, or in their stock or property of any kind.
