

# Supplementary Order Paper.

## LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL.

Wednesday, the 20th Day of September, 1939.

### MEAT BILL.

(NOTE.—*The amendments herein proposed have been recommended by the Agricultural and Pastoral Committee, or are consequential on amendments recommended by that Committee.*)

Clause 21, subclause (4): To omit the proviso to this subclause (page 14).

Clause 23, subclause (1): To omit from this subclause all words after the word “give” in line 29, and substitute the following words: “public notice of the period within which claims for refunds will be received by the local authority and shall give to every person who is entitled to receive the refund of any amount not less than *five* pounds notice of the fact that he is entitled to such refund”.

Clause 23, subclause (2): To insert the words “or depreciation” after the word “renewal” in line 20 (page 18).

Clause 23, subclause (4): To insert the words “or depreciation” after the word “renewal” in line 42.

Clause 23, subclause (6), paragraph (d): To insert the words “or depreciation” after the word “renewal” in line 36.

Clause 23: To insert, after subclause (6), the following new subclause:—

(6A) Every local authority to which this section applies shall be required to establish a renewal or depreciation fund in respect of the abattoir. In the case of a Borough Council all the provisions of Part XI of the Municipal Corporations Act, 1933, with respect to depreciation funds shall apply as if the establishment and maintenance of the abattoir were a trading undertaking within the meaning of the said Part. In the case of any other local authority those provisions shall, with any necessary modifications, apply as if the controlling local authority were a Borough Council. Any renewal or depreciation fund established by any local authority in respect of an abattoir before the commencement of this Act shall be deemed to be established in accordance with this section.

Third Schedule: To omit from the reference to the Wellington City Abattoir Charges and Renewal Fund Act, 1919, the words and figures “Sections 3 and 12, and subsection (3) of section 4”.
