Clause 5, line 37: To strike out the words "that the area selected."

Clauses 5A and 5B: To transpose these clauses.

Clause 6, line 15: To strike out the words, "except in the case of sales of Registrars of the Supreme Court on behalf of mortgagees"; and at the end of the clause to add the following proviso: "Provided that this section shall not apply to sales by any public officer by virtue of, or in exercise of, any statutory provision or authority."

Clause 49, line 41: The paragraph commencing "all the words" to be

a separate clause of the Bill; also to alter the words "five" and "eight" in lines 41 and 42 to "two" and "five" respectively.

Clause 52, line 10: To strike out the word "Native" before "Appellate." Clause 55, line 47: After "thirty-nine," to insert "of the Act."
