NATIVE RESERVES ACT AMENDMENT BILL.

The Hon. Mr. Williams, in Committee, to move the addition of the following new clauses :-

> A. Any Native over the age of sixteen years, whether under coverture or not, may from time to time give good and valid discharges for any moneys which he or she is entitled to receive from the Public Trustee under the principal Act or this Act, or may, by writing under his or her hand, attested by a Justice of the Peace, solicitor of the Supreme Court, or postmaster, authorise any other Native beneficiary under the principal Act to receive and give discharges for any such moneys, if actually due and payable when such authority is given; but every such authority shall be absolutely void if it relates to moneys which are not actually due and payable at the time when the authority is given.

> B. "The West Coast Settlement Reserves Act, 1892," is hereby amended by substituting the words "four years" for the words "twelve months" where the same occur in paragraph (k) of subsection three of section eight; and by the addition to section ten of the following words: "Provided that any insurance under the lease shall be as provided by the Fourth Schedule of "The Land Transfer

Act, 1885."
