NEW ZEALAND SOCIETY OF ACCOUNTANTS AMENDMENT BILL.

Hon. Mr. BELL, in Committee, to move the following amendments:—

Clause 2: To omit the word "words," and to add the following subclause:—

(2.) The Council may refuse to accept such resignation if it has good cause for believing that the member has been guilty of conduct which would justify his expulsion from the society or his removal from the Register, or if the member is indebted to the society.
