NEW ZEALAND SOCIETY OF ACCOUNTANTS BILL.

Hon. Dr. FINDLAY, in Committee, to move the following amendments:—

Clause 10: To omit the words "Provided always that it shall be lawful for any applicant," and to substitute therefor "(2.) Any applicant." To omit the words "to appeal from such," in line 19, and to substitute therefor "may appeal from that." To omit the word "such," in line 20.

Clause 14, subclause (3): To insert after the word "signed," in line 20, the words "by the person nominated and"; and to insert after the word "two," in the same line, the word "other."

Clause 34: To transpose subclauses two and three.
