PUBLIC WORKS AMENDMENT BILL.

Hon. Dr. FINDLAY, in Committee, to move the following new clause:—

Cancellation or section 117 of principal Act.

2A. (1.) When by any Order in Council issued in pursuance of variation of conditions im section one hundred and seventeen of the principal Act or under posed by Order section one hundred and seventeen of the Public Works Act, 1905, in Council under a seventeen of the Public Works Act, 1905, as amended by section three of the Public Works Act Amendment Act, 1906, conditions have been imposed with respect to the buildingline in the case of any street or road exempted from the provisions of those sections, the Governor may from time to time, by Order in Council, on the application of the local authority having control of that road or street, amend the first-mentioned Order in Council by cancelling or varying the conditions so imposed thereby, and any such cancellation or variation may extend either to the whole or to any part or parts of the said road or street.

(2.) A copy of every Order in Council issued under the authority of this section shall be transmitted under the hand of the Minister of Public Works to the District Land Registrar or the Registrar of Deeds, as the case may require, who shall register the same against the title of all land affected thereby, and the original Order in Council shall thereupon be deemed to be amended, and shall have

effect as so amended accordingly.
