PUBLIC WORKS AND GOVERNMENT RAILWAYS BILL.—CONSIDERATION OF AMENDMENTS PROPOSED BY HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR.

New Clauses.—Part I.

Whenever any unrepealed Act of the General Assembly incorporates or refers to any Part or Parts or any provisions of any Act repealed by the said Act, such unrepealed Act shall be deemed to incorporate or refer to the Part or Parts or provisions of the said Act corresponding to such repealed Parts or provisions, as the case may be.

If any cattle are found trespassing without lawful excuse on or within the boundaries of any railway open for traffic, the owner of such cattle, or the person having the charge, custody, or use thereof, is liable to a penalty not exceeding ten shillings for each head thereof, unless he satisfies the Court that the cattle were being driven along a road parallel to the railway which was not fenced, and that he used reasonable care to prevent trespass, and reasonable diligence in removing them when the trespass occurred.
