## SUPPLEMENTARY ORDER PAPER.

## LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL.

RESERVES, ENDOWMENTS, AND CROWN AND NATIVE LANDS EXCHANGE, SALE, DISPOSAL, AND ENABLING BILL.

Hon. Mr. W. C. WALKER, in Committee, to move to insert new clause to follow clause 51:-

> 51A. Whereas on the purchase by the Crown of certain land, known as the "Murihiku" Block, there was awarded by Mr. Commissioner Mantell to one Taiaroa (father of the Honourable H. K. Taiaroa) an area of one hundred acres of land at Milford Haven, but, owing to difficulties that arose, it was afterwards found to be impossible to give effect to the award, and the claim has never been satisfied, but the land in question is now available: Be it therefore enacted as follows:-

> The Governor may, after survey, grant to the Honourable Hori Kerei Taiaroa an area of one hundred acres of land at Anita Bay, Milford Sound, to be laid off in conformity with "The Land Act, 1892," provided that he shall first of all agree in writing to accept the same in full satisfaction of all claims and demands under the aforesaid

award.
