RELIGIOUS INSTRUCTION IN PUBLIC SCHOOLS ENABLING BILL.

Hon. Mr. CARRINGTON, in Committee, to move to add the following new clause:—

10A. (1) Every teacher who is of opinion that his <sup>Prevention of
victimization
of teachers.</sup> position in any school or his claim to any appointment is prejudicially affected by the fact of his having been exempted under section *six* or section *eight* of this Act may in writing setting forth all relevant facts supporting such opinion appeal to the Minister.

(2) On receiving any such appeal the Minister shall cause to be made such inquiry as he deems necessary, and if it appears from such inquiry that the position of such teacher or his claim to any appointment has in fact been affected as aforesaid the Minister may give to the Education Board or other governing authority concerned such directions as he deems necessary in the interests of the teacher, and it shall be the duty of such Board or other authority to take all steps necessary to give full effect to the Minister's decision.
