

SUPPLEMENTARY ORDER PAPER.

LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL.

Tuesday, the 29th day of June, 1886.

AMENDMENTS PROPOSED BY THE SELECT COMMITTEE UPON THE STOCK-DRIVING BILL.

Clause 1. Erase lines 2 and 3.

Clause 2. In line 3, erase "driving," and insert "being driven by."

Clause 3. In line 9, erase "Justice of the Peace or." In line 10, after "ranger," insert "or owner." In line 11, after "compare the," insert "number." Same line, after "brands," insert "and ear marks." Same line, after "with the," insert "number;" after "brands," insert "and ear marks."

Clause 4. Erase the clause, but add the last paragraph to clause 3.

Clause 5. To stand as clause 4. In line 1, erase "Justice of the Peace." In line 2, after "ranger," insert "owner." In line 8, after "such," erase "Justice." Same line, after "ranger," insert "owner."

Clause 6, to stand as clause 5.

Clause 7, to stand as clause 6.

New clause :—

To stand as clause 7 :

7. This Act shall extend and apply to such districts as the Governor shall, from time to time by Proclamation published in the *New Zealand Gazette*, declare to be subject to the provisions hereof; and the limits of such districts shall, for the purposes of this Act, be such as are defined in such Proclamation. And it shall be lawful for the Governor at any time to revoke any such Proclamation, and thereupon this Act shall cease to apply to the district named therein, unless reproclaimed.
