STOCK-REMEDIES BILL.

Hon. Mr. MASTERS, in Committee, to move the following amendments:—

Clause 13, subclause (3): To omit the words “with the particulars in the label of the receptacle from which the sample is taken or” in lines 27 to 29; and to omit the words “certificate as to whether” in line 34, and substitute the words “statement as to whether or not in his opinion”.

Clause 14, subclause (6): To omit the words “or certificates” in line 25.

Clause 14, subclause (7): To omit the words “label of the receptacle” in line 33, and substitute the words “application for the registration of the stock-remedy”.

Clause 19: To omit this clause, and substitute the following new clause:—

19A. (1) The Board may from time to time, in such manner as it thinks fit, publish the results of any experiments made with any stock-remedy sold in New Zealand, or, with the approval of the Minister, may publish with respect to any stock-remedy the results of any analysis thereof made under this Act or any particulars relating to such stock-remedy, if, in its opinion, based on the results of such analysis, the publication of such results or particulars is necessary for the protection of purchasers or otherwise in the public interest.

(2) No action shall lie against the Minister or any member of the Board or any other person in respect of the publication of any matter pursuant to this section.
