SURVEYORS BILL.

*Proposed Amendments.*

Hon. Mr. FAGAN, in Committee, to move the following amendments:—

Clause 29, paragraph (a): To add to this paragraph the following proviso:—

Provided that this paragraph shall not apply in any case where the District Land Registrar intimates in writing that he does not propose to exercise the power conferred on him by section one hundred and seventy-eight of the Land Transfer Act, 1915, to require the deposit of a plan.

Clause 29, paragraph (e): To insert, after the words “ purposes of ” in line 5, page 15, the words “ any coal-mining right under the Coal-mines Act, 1925, or ”; to insert, before the words “ mining privilege ” in line 7, the words “ coal-mining right or ”; to insert, before the word “ mining ” in line 9, the words “ coal-mining right ”.

(NOTE.—The above amendments to paragraph (e) will necessitate the alteration of the last line of the Reprint of Statutes reference in the margin to read “ Vol. V, pp. 843, 943 ”.)

Clause 29, paragraph (f): To omit the word “ which ” in line 12; to insert, before the word “ may ” in line 13, the words “ with intent that it ”; to omit the word “ reasonably ” in line 13.

Clause 29, paragraph (g): To omit the words “ Certifies to the accuracy ” in line 17, and substitute the words “ Being an officer of the Department of Lands and Survey, certifies to the correctness ”.

Clause 30: To insert “ (1) ” after “ 30 ” in line 22; to add the following as subclause (2):—

(2) No proceedings for an offence against this section shall be commenced except by information laid by the Secretary or some other officer of the Board or by a member of the Board, acting pursuant to a resolution of the Board. Every information for an offence against this section shall be deemed to have been laid in conformity with this subsection unless and until the contrary is proved.
