Hon. Mr. KELLY, in Committee, to move the following amendments:—

On page 2. Line 6: Erase "October," insert "January." Line 7: Erase "five," insert "six." Lines 15 and 16: Erase "has the same meaning as it has in 'The Mercantile Agents Act, 1890,'" and insert "includes any bill of lading, dock, warrant, warehouse-keeper's certificate, and warrant or order for the delivery of goods, and any other document used in the ordinary course of business, as proof of the possession or control of goods, or authorising or purporting to authorise, either by indorsement or by delivery, the possessor of the document to transfer or receive goods thereby represented." Line 21: Erase "or," insert "and." Same line: Erase "industrial." Line 46: Erase "bankrupt," insert "insolvent."

On page 9. Line 4: After "owner," insert "Provided that it, the lien or other right of the original seller is expressed in an instrument duly registered under 'The Chattels Transfer Act, 1889,' and if the person selling, pledging, or disposing of the goods is the mortgagor or bailee named in such instrument, then the person receiving the goods shall be deemed to have had notice of the contents of such instrument."

On page 11. Line 50: Erase "bankruptcy," insert "insolvency."

On page 12. Line 16: Erase "bankrupt," insert "insolvent." Line 36: Erase "bankrupt," insert "insolvent."

On page 16. Erase lines 12, 13, 14, and 15. Line 26: Erase "the transfer of," and, after "chattels," insert "transfer."
