STATUTES REPEAL AND EXPIRING LAWS AMENDMENT AND CONTINUANCE BILL

Hon. Sir FRANCIS BELL, in Committee, to move the following new clause:—

Duration of

Extension Act,  
1919, extended.      6A. (1.) Section four of the Mortgages Extension Act, 1919, is hereby amended by omitting the words “thirty-first day of December, nineteen hundred and twenty,” and substituting the words “thirtieth day of June, nineteen hundred and twenty-one.”

(2.) Section seven of the Mortgages Extension Act, 1919, is hereby amended as follows:—

(a.) By omitting from subsection one the words “thirty-first day of December, nineteen hundred and twenty,” and substituting the words “thirtieth day of June, nineteen hundred and twenty-one”; and

(b.) By omitting from subsection one the words “thirty-first day of December, nineteen hundred and twenty-one,” and substituting the words “thirtieth day of June, nineteen hundred and twenty-two.”
