TRANSPORT LICENSING AMENDMENT BILL.

Hon. Mr. FAGAN, in Committee, to move the following amendments:—

Clause 3, subclause (3): To omit the words “ and reasons therefor ” in lines 33 and 34; to insert, after the word “ thereof ” in line 37, the words “ Every such entry shall include a statement of the reasons for the decision to which it relates ”; to add to the subclause the words “ Any person may, on payment of such fee as may be prescribed, obtain a copy certified as aforesaid of any entry in the minute-book ”.

Clause 9: To add to the clause the following words: “ Every witness giving evidence in person at any public sitting shall first be duly sworn ”.

Clause 12: To insert after subclause (3) the following new subclause:—

(3A) For the purposes of every appeal under this section the Licensing Authority shall furnish to the Minister a copy of any notes of evidence taken by the Licensing Authority in connection with the subject-matter of the appeal.
