VICTORIA COLLEGE BILL IN COMMITTEE.

In clause 36, line 2, to omit "from the primary public schools (whether Government schools or not)."

Subsection (2) to be struck out.

In subsection (3), to add at the end thereof "The examination shall be open to all persons of either sex who are not over fourteen years of age, but not more than two scholarships shall be awarded in any year to scholars from any one school."

36. For the purpose of bringing higher education within the reach of deserving scholars from the primary public schools (whether Government schools or not) within the said provincial districts, there are hereby established in connection with the College, and out of its funds, scholarships to be called "Queen's scholarships," and with respect thereto the following provisions shall apply:—

(1.) Six scholarships shall in the prescribed manner be offered

for competition each year.

(2.) The candidates shall be scholars, from the aforesaid schools, not exceeding two from any one school, and they shall be nominated in the prescribed manner.

(3.) The scholarships shall be awarded on the results of an examination to be conducted in the prescribed manner by the Inspector General of schools Council The examination shall be open to all persons of either sex who are not over fourteen years of age, but not more than two scholarships shall be awarded in any year to scholars from any one school.
