Hon. Mr Thomson, in Committee, to move the following amendments:

That Part I (comprising *clauses 2 to 23*) be a separate Bill, and that for *clause 2* there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and Short Title:

An Act to amend the Armed Forces Discipline Act 1971

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. Short Title and commencement—(1) This Act may be cited as the Armed Forces Discipline Amendment Act 1980, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Armed Forces Discipline Act 1971 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

(2) This Act shall come into force on the date appointed

for the commencement of the principal Act.

That Part II (comprising *clauses 24 to 25A*) be a separate Bill, and that for *clause 24* there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and Short Title:

An Act to amend the Royal New Zealand Air Force Act 1950

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. Short Title—This Act may be cited as the Royal New Zealand Air Force Amendment Act 1980, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Royal New Zealand Air Force Act 1950.

That Part III (comprising *clauses 26 to 29*) be a separate Bill, and that for *clause 26* there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and Short Title:

An Act to amend the Courts Martial Appeals Act 1953

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. Short Title and commencement—(1) This Act may be cited as the Courts Martial Appeals Amendment Act 1980, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Courts Martial Appeals Act 1953 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

(2) This Act shall come into force on the date appointed for the commencement of the Armed Forces Discipline Act 1971.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This paper breaks the Bill into its 3 component Parts, and enables each Part to be finally enacted as a separate Act.
