ADULTERATION PREVENTION ACTS AMENDMENT BILL.

Mr. Taylor, in Committee, to move, That clause 4 be struck out.

MINING ACT AMENDMENT BILL.

Colonel Fraser, in Committee, to move the following new sections:—

Notwithstanding anything contained in "The Mining Act, 1891," the Governor in Council may from time to time, by Proclamation, withdraw from a mining district any portion of land situated therein, or any portion thereof, below a certain level, and, with the consent of all the licensees or occupiers thereof respectively, may grant a lease to any persons, company, or syndicate, for the purpose of mining upon the said land, subject to such conditions, covenants, and restrictions, and for such period, as to the Governor in Council shall seem fitting.

Every such Proclamation shall clearly define the land withdrawn as aforesaid by distinguishing-lines or measurements on the surface-

ground above.

WELLINGTON CITY SANITATION LOAN EMPOWERING BILL.

Mr. McLean to move, in Committee, the following new section:—

That, before any loan is authorised by this Act, the Corporation shall, upon taking the votes of the ratepayers upon the question whether a loan should be authorised, also take a vote of the ratepayers whether the special rate to be levied shall be levied upon the unimproved value of the land as assessed under "The Land and Income Assessment Act, 1891."
