Dr Wall, in Committee, to move the following amendment:

Clause 7: To add the words ", and substituting the words ', and that the danger cannot reasonably be averted by any other treatment or procedure normally carried out during pregnancy'."

EXPLANATORY NOTE

As clause 7 is drafted in the Bill, it would omit from section 187A (1) (a) of the Crimes Amendment Act 1977 the words ", and that the danger cannot be averted by any other means". The amendment now proposed would substitute for those words the words ", and that the danger cannot reasonably be averted by any other treatment or procedure normally carried out during pregnancy".
