COUNTIES ACT AMENDMENT BILL.

Mr. FIELD, in Committee, to move the following new clauses:—

A. The Council may, in addition to the powers conferred by "The Counties Act, 1886," do all things necessary to light such streets, roads, bridges, and other public places and public buildings within the county as may to the Council appear necessary or expedient, and specially to do the following things:—

- (1.) May lay pipes under and wires under or over all streets, roads, and public places within the county;
- (2.) May erect lamp-posts with all requisite fittings thereto in such streets, roads, and public places.

B. The Council may contract with any person, company, or corporation for lighting such streets, roads, bridges, and other public places and public buildings by gas, electricity, kerosene, or such other mode as may be considered more suitable and upon such terms and conditions as it thinks fit.

C. The cost of lighting such streets, roads, bridges, and other public places and public buildings shall be paid out of the general account of the county fund.
