COUNTIES ACT AMENDMENT BILL.

Hon. Sir J. G. WARD, in Committee, to move the following new clause:—

Private
tramways in
counties where
Act not in force.

4. (1.) The powers conferred on the Governor by section three of "The Counties Act Amendment Act, 1903," of authorising the construction of a tramway in counties in which the principal Act is not in force, shall extend and apply to the granting of a license under section seventeen of "The Tramways Act, 1894," to construct and maintain a private tramway in counties in which the principal Act is not in force.

(2.) For the purposes of this section the functions of the local authority under sections seventeen to nineteen of "The Tramways Act, 1894," may be exercised by the Governor or any person authorised by him in that behalf.
