CIVIL AVIATION AMENDMENT BILL

Proposed Amendments

Hon. Mr Gordon, in Committee, to move the following amendments:

Clause 4: To omit from line 9 on page 2 the words "Air Accidents Inspectorate", and substitute the words "Office of Air Accidents Investigation"; and to omit from line 11 on page 2 the word "Safety", and substitute the word "Accidents".

New clause: To add the following clause:

5. Regulations—Section 29 of the principal Act is hereby amended by inserting in subsection 4, after the words "for the purpose of ensuring the safety of aircraft", the words "or, after consultation with such persons interested in civil aviation as the Minister may direct, for the purpose of abating the noise made by aircraft".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The amendment to clause 4 of the Bill changes the name of the "Office of Air Safety Investigation" to that of "Office of Air Accidents Investigation".

The new clause 5 empowers the Director of the Civil Aviation Division to issue instructions, orders, or requirements for the purpose of abating noise made by aircraft. Before issuing any such instruction, order, or requirement, the Director is to consult such civil aviation interests as the Minister of Transport may direct.
