CIVIL AVIATION AMENDMENT BILL (NO. 2)

Proposed Amendments

Hon. W. ROB STOREY, in Committee, to move the following amendments:

Clause 1: To omit from line 12 on page 2 the expression "1st day of July 1992", and substitute the words "day on which this Act receives the Royal assent".

Clause 26: To omit from line 8 on page 29 the expression "1st day of July 1992", and substitute the words "commencement of this Act".

Clause 35: To omit from lines 19 and 20 on page 36 the expression "on the 30th day of June 1992", and substitute the words "immediately before the commencement of this Act".

To omit from line 31 on that page the expression "1st day of July 1992", and substitute the words "commencement of this Act".

To omit from line 38 on that page the expression "1st day of July 1992", and substitute the words "commencement of this Act".

To omit from lines 11 and 12 on page 37 the expression "1st day of July 1992", and substitute the words "commencement of this Act".

To omit from lines 14 and 19 on that page the expression "1st day of July 1992", and substitute in each case the words "commencement of this Act".

To omit from line 20 on that page the expression "after the 30th day of June 1992", and substitute the words "on or after the commencement of this Act".

To omit from lines 23 and 24 on that page the expression "after that 30th day of June", and substitute the words "on or after the date of that commencement".

Clause 35A: To omit from lines 3 and 4 on page 38 the expression "1st day of July 1992", and substitute the words "commencement of this Act".

Clause 36: To omit from line 32 on page 38 the words "that financial year", and substitute the words "this Act".

Clause 37: To omit from lines 7 and 12 on page 39 the expression "1st day of July 1992", and substitute in each case the words "commencement of this Act".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This Supplementary Order Paper changes the commencement date in *clause 1* of the Civil Aviation Amendment Bill (No. 2) in order to bring the Bill into force on the day on which the Bill receives the Royal assent, rather than on 1 July 1992, and effects consequential changes to other provisions.
