COUNTIES AMENDMENT BILL.

Hon. Mr. HINE, in Committee, to move to add the following new clause:—

County Councils
may provide
doctors'
residences.

3. The authority conferred on County Councils by sections thirty-one and thirty-two of the Counties Amendment Act, 1913, to provide dwellings for workers is hereby extended, and shall be deemed at all times since the passing of that Act to have extended, so as to authorize any such Council to provide a residence for any registered medical practitioner engaged in the practice of his profession in the county, and the provisions of those sections and also of section thirty-three of that Act shall apply accordingly.
